Thanks in part to receiving a WES grant, **Cristina Castellanos (pictured right)** is looking forward to a **bright future in Medical Assisting**. She likes being the link between patient and doctor and wants to have a meaningful career that helps people. Last spring in her final semester of the Medical Assisting program, her mother was at the end stage of Alzheimer’s disease and Cristina needed to care for her, which meant that she couldn’t keep up the tutoring work she did to pay for her childcare. Thankfully a WES advisor stepped in and arranged for a WES grant, which arrived a few days later and allowed her to pay her bills.

The WES Committee (pictured below) proudly announced that WES will award \$63,000 in grants this year — a new record! Also, this year’s campaign was spurred to new heights by a \$10,000 matching grant from the Sharanam Foundation and the Wedeen Hammer Group at Morgan Stanley, which matched gifts \$250 and greater.

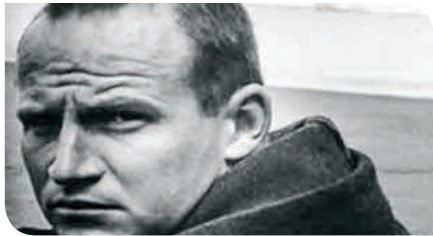

Rod Lundquist

As a Cabrillo Faculty member, Rod Lundquist spent many happy years in the English Department. Prior to that, in the 1950s and 1960s he spent years chasing waves and pioneered big wave surfing (pictured above in 1965). Recalls Bill “PeeWee” Bergerson in a 1992 New Yorker article, “Lundquist was ahead of his time. He used to surf Ocean Beach on huge days alone. No leash. No wetsuit. He wore Speedo trunks. Rode a longboard. He left to go teach college in Santa Cruz.”

Rod passed away in 2016 leaving his home to the Cabrillo College Foundation in his estate plans. His generous gift of \$1,314,904 will support the Rod Lundquist Faculty Grant Endowment to enhance learning and student success. Longtime friend and colleague Nancy Brown remembered his love for Cabrillo, “He told me he would work at Cabrillo for free — just for the privilege of hanging around the place.” Rod’s passion for teaching and Cabrillo will live on in this program to benefit our faculty.



Daryl Dill

In 1998 Daryl Dill established the Mom Endowed Scholarship (Irene Streu Dill) in honor of his mother, a teacher in the Midwest. Daryl passed away in 2015 knowing that his estate gift of \$200,000 will assist many future educators.

He would have liked meeting this year’s recipient; Rosio Perez (pictured above with her son Sam). She is studying early education at Cabrillo. “Returning to school has been by far one of the best decisions I have ever made. To have a complete stranger invest his money into my education is truly amazing; this person believes in me and might as well be sitting next to my son who is also cheering me on. For that I am eternally grateful. Receiving the Mom Scholarship has given me the priceless confirmation I was looking for; I can be a successful student and a successful single mom.”

Edward and Alpeda Rampone

Visit any healthcare facility in the county and you will find skilled and caring Cabrillo graduates providing your care. Helping to ensure that continues, twenty years ago, Edward and Alpeda Rampone met with their attorney and decided to leave a large portion of their estate to Cabrillo College. After Alpeda passed away in 1994, Edward had an excellent health care team that helped him stay nimble enough to enjoy his passion for dancing, particularly the foxtrot, jitterbug, and samba. Edward passed away in 2015 and his \$100,000 estate gift has established the Edward and Alpeda P. Rampone Memorial Endowed Nursing Scholarship, which will be awarded annually to deserving nursing students.

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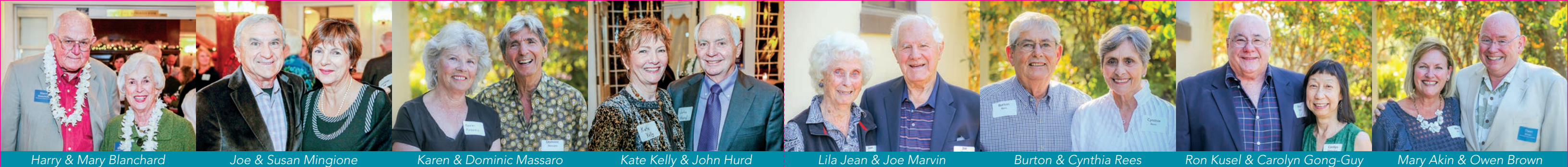
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LOVE SPOKEN HERE

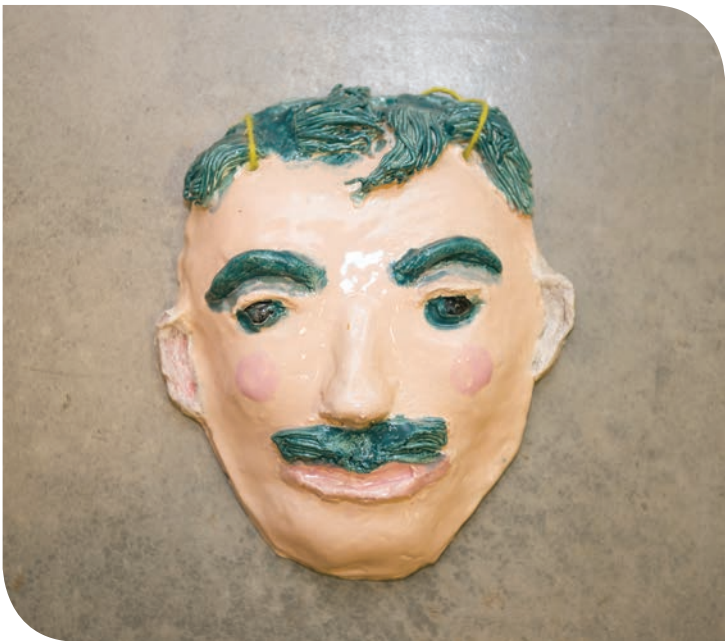

You notice a joyful sense of community when you pass through the doors of Cabrillo’s Stroke and Learning Disability Center.

Adaptive Yoga students share a smile with the instructor as they curl themselves into poses. A counseling session is punctuated with a bellowing laugh. “Love Spoken Here” is more than just a motto at the center.

Since 1974, the center has picked up where rehabilitation leaves off, teaching students skills to navigate life after a stroke or disabling event. The center offers an array of counseling, speech, and mobility classes. The HEART Program Classes offered through Extension provide further opportunities to learn skills such as choir to help with language and ceramics and painting for both physical skills and expressing creativity. 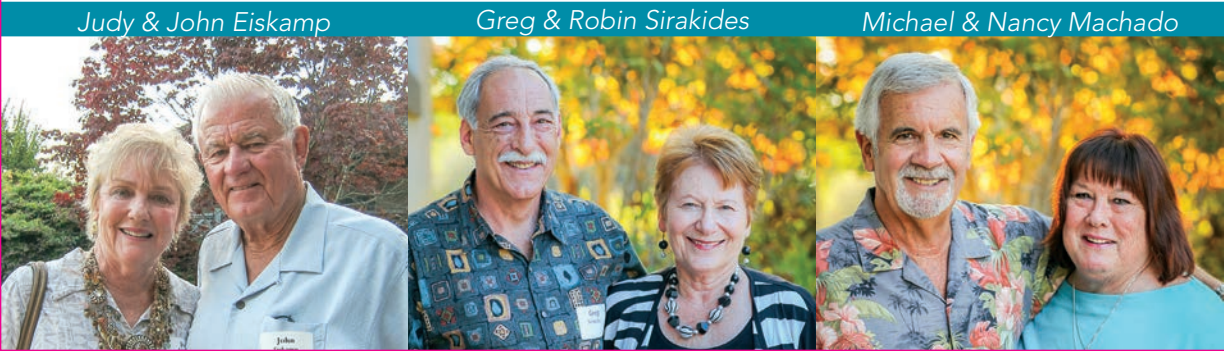
This essential program serves the community with the help of many private donations totaling over \$78,000 last year.

Long-time philanthropist George Ow, Jr. and his family have been providing American Dream Scholarships of \$500 to local ethnic minority high school seniors for 27 years. Since 1989, the Ow Family has awarded over \$526,000 to 1,297 graduating high school students coming to Cabrillo.

The Ow family awarded 112 high school seniors American Dream scholarships in May. It is just one of the many ways the Ow Family has supported students and the mission of Cabrillo College over the years.

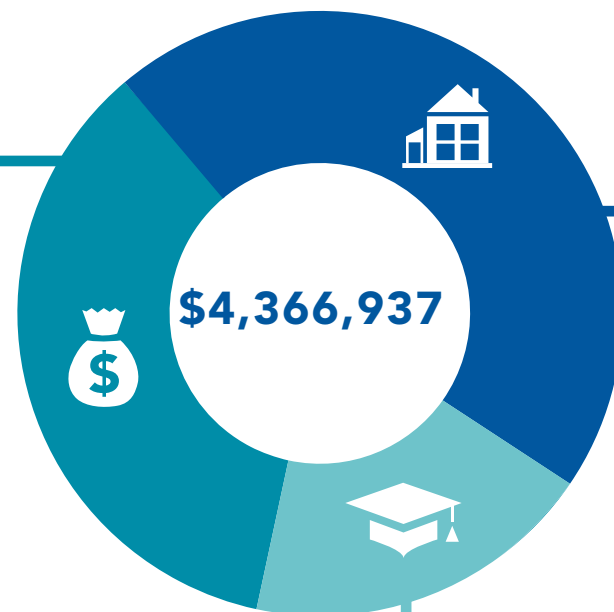

The Monterey Peninsula Foundation is playing stork and delivering Cabrillo's nursing program with the perfect training tool to improve learning.

The Monterey Peninsula Foundation, host of the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (MPF), has awarded Cabrillo with \$200,000 to improve simulation learning for students. Students can practice high stakes medical emergencies that rarely occur, which builds experience and competence. This will improve student performance and increase success on the nursing state board exams.

In addition to the lifelike tot, the grant provides funding for a new mother mannequin. MPF is also funding projects for the Cabrillo Youth Chorus, Athletics programs, STEM Tutoring, and the Cabrillo Advancement Program (CAP).
