EXECUTIVE MESSAGE

Thank you for making 2018 a remarkable year for the Cabrillo College Foundation! The community has welcomed our new President, Matthew Wetstein, and he has worked tirelessly to meet our students, staff and our community of supporters.

With your help, the foundation continues to support our students in meaningful ways. We put over \$1 million in scholarship funds in the hands of students and \$1.3 million to student services and faculty support, such as programs that provide a safe space for former foster youth to study, tutoring, grants for faculty and more. The appreciation for Cabrillo and our students is strong and emphatic. Our students continue to face headwinds with the increasing cost of housing in our community — even hunger is an increasing concern, so helping students launch a career or transfer to a four-year college is as critical as ever.

WOMEN'S EDUCATIONAL SUCCESS (WES)

"I made the decision to go back to school and it has completely changed my life," reflects Dahlia, a hard-working student pursuing her dream. "My heart has always been in the medical field." She currently has a 4.0 grade average in the Medical Assisting program. She loves her classes and her program, so when she hit a crisis in her relationship, she turned to her faculty for help. "I didn't ask for money," she recalls, "I just needed support." They connected her to helpful resources, but realized she would need a little extra money to ensure her well-being and that of her son. They arranged for her to receive a WES grant of \$500, which she received the next day!

The Cabrillo community is pulling for our students to succeed. If a student has an emergency that threatens their education, the Women's Educational Success (WES) program helps our faculty and staff intervene with essential cash. Our WES Advisors are empowered to give a grant of up to \$750, often in as little as a week to a student who needs help. The WES program is funded by private donations and will award \$75,000 to students in need — providing a safety net for students like Dahlia.

The WES Committee, also known as Best Friends, champion the annual WES fundraising campaign. They are getting a helping hand from the Sharanam Foundation and the Wedeen Hammer Group at Morgan Stanley, who teamed up to match gifts of \$250 or more up to \$10,000.






The foundation was amazed to learn of an estate gift that had been planned originally in 1977. Through this gift, we have come to know one of Cabrillo's most generous benefactors and an extraordinary woman, Evelyn Pelz, whose appreciation for Cabrillo will give students a boost for years to come.

Evelyn Pelz was the mother of two sons living in Pasatiempo, when her eldest son Bill attended Cabrillo on the GI Bill. She was so impressed with his experience she committed to leaving Cabrillo in her estate plans. According to those who knew her, she was a deeply spiritual woman who believed the world worked in mysterious, but magical ways.


With 41 years of careful stewardship by her friend and noted investor, Arnold Van Den Berg, Cabrillo received \$1,170,507 to establish the Pelz Family Endowment to support the area of greatest need at Cabrillo College. Each year, this will help fund college priorities that aren't funded through traditional channels. This will allow the entire college to benefit in perpetuity and the generous and kind spirit of Mrs. Pelz will live on.

CABRILLO ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM (CAP)

The Cabrillo Advancement Program (CAP) has guided hundreds of students toward graduation. Each year, the program identifies 60 low-income sixth graders in Santa Cruz County to receive counseling, after-school tutoring, family outreach and support for academic development. Students who graduate from high school are eligible to receive \$3,000 for their first and second years at Cabrillo.

Colligan Family Scholarship

During our graduation ceremony last spring, Cabrillo President Matt Wetstein asked the graduates to stand if they were first in their family to attend college. Well over half collectively stood. It was a moving moment that demonstrated the vital role Cabrillo plays in introducing new families to the benefits afforded by a college education. While many First Generation students are honored to have opportunities that their parents have not had, we know it comes with challenges as well. Thanks to Bud and Rebecca Colligan, some of the financial stressors will be eased through the new Colligan Family Scholarship. The Colligans have made a multi-year promise to help 100 students a year with scholarship funds. "We believe in the power of education to truly transform lives and families," says Bud Colligan.



"I am the first male in my family to get a college degree. I'm working on my transfer units to San Jose State to go into Sports Medicine and I would like to be a chiropractor someday, as well. I receive grants and financial aid through Cabrillo. It's a blessing to have resources at Cabrillo that allow me to be a full time student and to focus on my classes completely. LASTING IMPACT

Wanda Garner was a beloved faculty member at Cabrillo College for 30 years before her long-deserved retirement in 2016. She retired as the Dean of Natural and Applied Sciences and was the force behind math, science, and engineering for many years at Cabrillo College. To honor Wanda in her retirement, Cabrillo faculty, staff and friends banded together to establish the Wanda Garner Scholarship, which was given as a surprise gift at her retirement party.

In 2017, Wanda passed away unexpectedly, leaving friends and family shaken. Wanda's legacy includes a commitment to educating students and teaching the teachers. A gift of \$150,000 from Lee and John Garner in memory of Wanda, their sister, will be divided evenly to endow the Wanda Garner Scholarship and establish the Wanda Garner Professional Development Endowment for Math Faculty. Lee and John's generous gift in memory of Wanda will provide support for math students and faculty through scholarship awards and professional development funding in perpetuity.

She was such a brilliant woman with a disarming wit, and even bigger heart. Wanda was respected and well known for her intellect, integrity, work ethic, advancement of STEM and her ability to be a great friend to the people in her life. Her hard work and dedication made a tremendous impact on Cabrillo College and on the lives of so many students.






