WOMEN'S EDUCATIONAL SUCCESS (WES)



"Support of WES is personal for me. I grew up in a home that did not value education and it was not an option pursued. I had great mentors, attended a community college, and in the long run went on to get an MBA. Education changed my life, and I wanted to give back to those where a small need can be met quickly. The Women's Educational Success program — often abbreviated to WES — is a lifeline for so many of our students at Cabrillo.

Students find that relatively small hardships — the cost of a book or a car repair — can make them consider dropping out of school entirely. WES provides quick relief with grants of up to \$1,000 that are usually received the same week. At our first ever virtual event, recent WES recipient Jenna described the grant she received as a "breath of fresh air" as she struggled to continue taking STEM classes for prerequisites to apply for PhD programs in Oceanography. Laid off from her State Park job at Año Nuevo because of the pandemic, Jenna shared, "It's been tough since February, so I was almost not going to continue. This really did make a big difference, so that I was able to focus on school. I really appreciate all of you that support WES."

The WES committee, known as Best Friends, raised an awe inspiring \$184,000 to support students like Jenna and so many others that need a little extra help to stay on track.


Melissa was a mother of two girls at the age of twenty, homeless, trying to leave an abusive relationship, when Child Protective Services stepped in and placed her own children in foster care. "That turned out to be a blessing in disguise, because I just didn't have a support system to help me, but that experience woke me up and that was my opportunity to really start focusing and figuring out exactly what I needed to do," she recalled, "that really was my wake up call. I was able to get my children back really quickly. That's what led me down my pathway to Cabrillo."

When she got to Cabrillo, she first tried to figure it out on her own, but when she had no way to pay for books she was guided to the Guardian Scholars Program. There she found a safe place to study, people to help connect her with needed services, but most importantly, "It really was a safe space to be vulnerable and ask for help. They're capable people and that in itself creates a sense of security. It allows you to build trust. A lot of people don't realize that trust is the biggest issue for anybody who's ever been in the foster youth system.

It was a very transformational stage for me, and that is why my heart is with Cabrillo. That was the first place I proved to myself that I was right to believe in ME."

Boosting Educational Attainment

Former foster youth struggle to attain higher education relative to their peers. The Guardian Scholars program at Cabrillo is making progress at closing the gap.



CABRILLO ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM (CAP)



The CAP program offers tutoring and mentoring to low-income youth in our county with the aim of guiding them towards a college education. Recent graduate José started the CAP program in 6th grade and shows us what is possible for students in this innovative program.

"The CAP program was like having a second family that was there for you when you needed it. Between the CAP after school tutoring and the summer academies, CAP made it easy to get help with homework and keep us on track. The great thing about the summer academies is it was a great way to tour the Cabrillo campus before I even started thinking about college.

I have graduated from Cabrillo with my Associates in Radiologic Technology. I am currently working in the field and loving every minute of it!

I'm so glad that I was able to be shown a path by the CAP Program and take it all the way to the finish line."

SCHOLARSHIPS UNLOCK THE DOOR TO CABRILLO

2020 Distinguished Alumni Award — George Ow, Jr.

George Ow, Jr. is a successful product of the community college system and a model of how far anyone can go with a college education. The Board of Directors of the Community College League of California selected him as a recipient of the 2020 Distinguished Alumni Award in recognition of his achievements and generosity.

In 1989, he and his family established the American Dream Scholarship Program at Cabrillo College, providing \$500 scholarships to local graduating high school students attending Cabrillo. For over 30 years, the Ow Family contributions to the Cabrillo Foundation total more than \$800,000.

The American Dream is that much closer for the hundreds of local students this aid has helped.





Colligan Family Scholarship for First Generation Students

Being first at anything is always hard, and being first in a family to get a college education is no exception. A scholarship to ease that burden was awarded to 107 deserving students through the **Colligan Family Scholarship** and celebrated in a virtual celebration in July 2020.

Bud Colligan encouraged the recipients, "We know that education is the foundation of everything and to the extent that you can get a good education then your chances of realizing your dreams is so much higher."

"Getting to this point was rough for me, especially being a first generation college student. I have a single, undocumented mother, who could not give me educational advice, since she never even got to high school back in Mexico. I have had to get to this point with the help of school counselors, with uncertainty in myself. But I want to set an example for my younger sister, so I will keep pushing forward.
